As a reminder, these events are not the only way to receive a vaccine. In-network pharmacies and providers may also administer preventive vaccines. Please visit PEBP's [Find a Provider \(nv.gov\)](#) page to search the directories. For UMR insurance holders, CVS and Walgreens are in-network.

The **shingles vaccine** is taken in two doses, two to six months apart. For additional doses, schedule an appointment at a participating in-network pharmacy, or schedule an appointment with your primary care provider (PCP).

Administrative leave is authorized per NAC 284.589.6(b) for **active employees** attending a PEBP coordinated event. PEBP recommends employees work with their supervisor to request approval to attend a clinic.
