Dear PEBP Participant,

Open Enrollment (OE) for Plan Year 2027 (PY27) will take place from **May 1st- May 31st** for the Public Employees' Benefits Program (PEBP). Beginning on May 1st, updated PY27 materials will be available on the OE page at <https://www.pebp.nv.gov>, which will include Master Plan documents, member guides, and training resources such as the OE Live Event Walkthrough E-PEBP portal video and other educational resources. Please visit the [What's New](#) page to view the updated rates and changes for the upcoming plan year, to help you stay informed before you make any changes. Retirees enrolled in a medical plan through Via Benefits and their eligible spouses/domestic partners have the option to enroll in PEBP Dental coverage or to decline if currently enrolled. To enroll in or decline PEBP Dental coverage, log into your [E-PEBP Portal](#) at <https://www.pebp.nv.gov/> during OE. **If you do not want to make any changes, no action is required.**

Please Note

Participants who want to make changes to their coverage should complete their enrollment and upload all required documents through the E-PEBP Portal during the designated Open Enrollment period. If the online event, including submitting any supporting documents, is not finished within that timeframe, the request cannot be processed, and changes will need to wait until the next Open Enrollment period or a qualifying life event.

PY2027 Monthly PEBP Dental Premium Effective July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2027

Plan Year 2027 PEBP Dental premium rates for State retirees, Non-State retirees, and their eligible spouses and domestic partners are available at <https://www.pebp.nv.gov/> on the What's New page, and will be in effect on July 1st.

Eligibility for PEBP Dental Coverage

Retirees **must** be enrolled in a supplemental medical plan through Via Benefits to participate in PEBP Dental. Eligible spouses/domestic partners must be enrolled in Medicare to participate in PEBP Dental. Retirees are required to maintain medical coverage through Via Benefits to continue PEBP benefits. TRICARE for Life retirees do not need to enroll in a plan through Via Benefits to participate in PEBP Dental.

Monthly HRA Contribution (effective July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2027)

The monthly Exchange Health Reimbursement Arrangement (HRA) contribution is \$13 per month, per year of service (YOS). The table below reflects the HRA contribution amounts for eligible retirees. You can find the *Medicare Exchange Health Reimbursement Arrangement Summary* at <https://www.pebp.nv.gov/> under *Open Enrollment* during the OE period, or under *Getting to Know Your Plan* during the rest of the plan year to help you understand how the HRA works.

How to determine your HRA contribution

- Retirees who retired BEFORE January 1, 1994, receive the 15-year base contribution monthly.
- For participants who retired ON OR AFTER January 1, 1994, the monthly contribution is based on years of service.
- Participants who were hired ON OR AFTER January 1, 2012, do not receive a subsidy. Those hired between 2010-2012 must have a minimum of 15 years to receive a subsidy or retire under a long-term disability plan.
- Spouses/domestic partners do not receive a contribution.

Health Reimbursement Arrangement

For HRA reimbursement, plan provisions dictate there is a 365-day period to file claims from the date the services were incurred. No plan benefits will be paid for any claim submitted after this period.

Important Information Regarding your Benefits

To maintain PEBP Benefits (such as HRA funding, life insurance, dental, and voluntary benefits) eligible retirees MUST continue to pay their Part B premiums and maintain enrollment in a supplemental medical plan through Via Benefits.
